

Who are Penny Brohn UK?

Penny Brohn UK is a national cancer charity that helps people live well with the impact of cancer, by showing them how to pay attention to their mind, body, spirit and emotions. The charity is a pioneer in integrated health - combining complementary, wellbeing therapies and lifestyle medicine that work alongside medical treatment to help each individual find the support they need to live well with cancer.

How it works at GenesisCare

GenesisCare and Penny Brohn UK work together to provide personalised complementary and wellbeing therapies tailored to your needs. When you are referred to GenesisCare, you'll be assigned a Penny Brohn Wellbeing Consultant. You'll have a holistic needs assessment with your Wellbeing Consultant to reflect on what your strengths are and where you might need help. This enables you to identify what concerns you most about your diagnosis, treatment and general wellbeing. From this, together

with your care team, we'll design a series of therapies that aim to alleviate your concerns and improve your quality of life.

This might include a range of complementary and wellbeing therapies including acupuncture, counselling, mindfulness meditation, reflexology, relaxation and group-based wellbeing and experience sharing. You'll be offered a series of wellbeing sessions fitted in around your treatments, all on-site at your chosen GenesisCare centre.



Penny Brohn UK has developed the evidence-based Bristol Whole Life Approach that addresses each part of a person — the mind, body, spirit and emotions — recognising that they are all interconnected and work together to support the immune system.

Research shows that emotions like fear, anger and shock may increase stress and result in the immune system not working at its best. We can't eliminate these natural emotions from our lives, but Penny Brohn UK can help you find ways to manage them.







Evaluation

At the end of your initial wellbeing sessions, we'll ask you to complete another questionnaire to check that your concerns have been successfully addressed. Our experience is that most

people will see a big improvement in how they feel after their initial sessions.

Sharon's story

Sharon was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2018 after finding a lump in her breast. She received chemotherapy and radiotherapy at our GenesisCare Centre in Milton Keynes.

"My breast cancer diagnosis came as a huge shock to me. I didn't really know how to feel about it all. I just wanted to keep everything as normal as possible for my husband and our two teenage sons.

"The Penny Brohn centre at GenesisCare offered me a safe haven when I was being faced with a massive schedule of treatment" After I started my treatment at GenesisCare, I was told about the support I could receive from Penny Brohn UK. The centre at GenesisCare was a very calm

environment and I immediately gravitated to my Penny Brohn Wellbeing Consultant, Bev. She was warm and open and the first person I was able to really talk to about how I was feeling in a meaningful way.

Sharon with her husband, Navin, and their sons, Nathan and Gabriel. I found a session on mindfulness with Bev really helpful — it allowed me to process the feelings that I couldn't make sense of before.

Between my sixth and seventh rounds of chemotherapy, my willpower started to dwindle. The steroids were affecting my sleep and making me feel anxious. Bev suggested that I try reflexology and it helped immediately! I had my first good night's sleep in a long time.

After my chemotherapy, I started 23 sessions of radiotherapy. Through Penny Brohn, I tried acupuncture which helped relieve the side effects I experienced.



Now that my treatment has ended, I reguarly keep in touch with Bev. The Penny Brohn service at GenesisCare offered me a safe haven when I was being faced with a massive schedule of treatment. The therapies and support I received not only helped me deal with the side effects, but also gave me emotional resilience and allowed me to be more in touch with myself."



Does the GenesisCare integrative approach work?

The simple answer is 'yes'. The vast majority of our patients come away from their Penny Brohn UK experience feeling a lot more positive about their life with cancer and what the future holds for them. 


