Our purpose-built GenesisCare centre in Oxford delivers world-class diagnostic and cancer care

Cancer treatment and care is constantly evolving and, as a global organisation, GenesisCare stays abreast of the latest evidence-based treatments from around the world, investing in those that will benefit our patients here in the UK.

The main approaches to cancer care are early detection and diagnosis so cancers can be more easily treated, surgery to remove tumours, radiotherapy to target and destroy cancer cells and difficult-to-reach tumours, and chemotherapy – a wide range of drug therapies that destroy specific cancer cells.

At our Oxford centre, we provide many of these treatments and use some of the most advanced techniques to treat all types of cancer.*

These include powerful advanced 3T MRI (magnetic resonance imaging) for very detailed scans, precision radiotherapy techniques that are proven safe and effective for difficult-to-reach tumours while limiting dose to healthy tissue and high-dose radiotherapy for shorter treatment duration.





We are a centre of excellence for stereotactic radiosurgery (SRS), which is non-invasive surgery for brain tumours, and have the UK's first MRIdian – the latest precision radiotherapy for prostate, lung, pancreatic and liver cancers.

All patients are offered access to wellbeing therapies during their treatment at no extra cost to them or their insurer through our unique partnership with the Penny Brohn UK cancer charity.

Our patients are referred to us from across the Oxfordshire area as well as further afield and we have a reputation for delivering excellent care. We are proud to have been rated "outstanding" by the Care Quality Commission for the quality of our care.



Here for you

These are some of the different experts and support staff who make up our teams.

Your care will be led by a consultant oncologist who will work alongside our experienced team based here at our centre and partner hospitals.

Together they will manage your personalised treatment and care plan.

Consultant oncologist

All of our consultant oncologists also work in large regional NHS hospitals. This means they have a very wide knowledge and experience and are familiar with the Oxfordshire healthcare networks. They use various methods to treat cancer, including chemotherapy and radiotherapy.

Diagnostic radiographer

Uses imaging techniques, such as MRI and CT, to capture and interpret scans and reports their findings to your consultant.

Therapy radiographer

Involved in radiotherapy planning scans, treatment planning and delivering radiotherapy. You'll see them at every radiotherapy session.

Haematologist

A consultant who specialises in disorders of the blood, including leukaemia, lymphoma or myeloma.

Radiologist

A consultant who specialises in using imaging techniques to diagnose and stage disease.

Dosimetrist

Helps your oncologist plan your radiotherapy treatment to destroy cancer cells while limiting damage to healthy tissues.

Physicist

Measures the dose of radiation you receive during radiotherapy to ensure it is safe and as prescribed by your oncologist.

Chemotherapy nurse

Administers and monitors chemotherapy, helps evaluate the effectiveness of treatment and advises on side effects and aftercare.

Pharmacist

Dispenses medicines as prescribed by your oncologist and assists in clinical trials.

Clinical nurse specialist

Has additional training in a particular cancer, to help treat and manage cancer-specific symptoms or treatment side effects.
We have clinical nurse specialists for breast, brain, and head and neck cancer.

Penny Brohn wellbeing consultant

Provides complementary and wellbeing therapies that are proven to ease cancer-related concerns.

Patient administration officer
